
# OVERVIEW




# Day One

# Day Three




- Morning round of golf at the Portmarnock Links. Designed by Bernhard Langer this scenic setting is the former grounds of Jameson Estate and will feature breathtaking views of Howth and the Ireland's Eye. The Portmarnock Links was the home of the 2008 and 2009 Ladies Irish Open.
- An afternoon guided tour into Dublin making stops at the Jameson Distillery, Trinity College, St. Stephens Green and multiple pubs favored by the locals.


# Day Four



- Morning round of golf at the Portmarnock Old Course. Former host of the Irish open. This historic links in which opened in 1884, will be home to the Irish Ametuer Championship in 2019. Tiger Woods regularly adds this course to his rotation in his preparation of the British Open
- An afternoon guided tour of Malahide Castle. If weather is permitting, this will be followed by a scenic cliff walk in Howth with views of Dublin Bay and Howth Village. Stopping at a boutique pub for beverages and having dinner at O'Dwyers pub in Portmarnock on the way back to the hotel.

# Day Five


